- 1) Students who transfer with an A.A. in Social Work from Bucks County Community College are considered GenEd-to-GenEd and have satisfied all of Temple's General Education requirements.
- 2) Students should select any transferable Biology course. A Biology course is required for Temple's BSW. Students transferring without a Biology course may require additional time to degree completion.
- 3) PSY 105 transfers to Temple as TRSS\*\*\*: Transfer Social Science. Credit for PSY 105 will satisfy Temple's SW 3011: The Social Worker in the Group, a major requirement at Temple, via DARS exception.
- 4) Students should select ECON120: Current Economic Issues; ECON111: Principles of Macroeconomics; or ECON112: Principles of Microeconomics. ECON120 transfers to Temple as ECON 1103: Global Economy Issues. ECON111 transfers to Temple as ECON 1101: Macroeconomic Principles. ECON112 transfers to Temple as ECON 1102: Microeconomic Principles. Any of these three courses can be used to satisfy the economics course requirement for the Bachelor of Social Work degree at Temple University. Students transferring without one of these three courses may require additional time to degree completion.

- Temple University requires that all undergraduate degree candidates complete 45 hours of the last 60 hours of the degree or program as matriculated students at Temple University. If a matriculated student previously took Temple courses on a non-matriculated basis, those courses are counted towards this requirement.
- d) Per Temple's Transfer Policy for Permission to Complete a Course at Another Institution after Matriculation, students who transfer 60 credits or more cannot receive permissions to transfer additional course work
