- 3) Students should select EN 201: Introduction to Literature. EN 201 transfers to Temple as ENGL 2001: Introduction to Literature and satisfies a major requirement. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.
- 4) Students should select SC 220: Intro to Geology. SC 220 transfers to Temple as EES 2001: Physical Geology and satisfies a major requirement. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.

If a matriculated student previously took Temple courses on a non-matriculated basis, those courses are counted towards this requirement.
- d) Per Temple's Transfer Policy for <u>Permission to Complete a Course at Another Institution after Matriculation</u>, students who transfer 60 credits or more cannot receive permissions to transfer additional course work.
- e) Students may seek a waiver of the foreign language requirement on the basis previous experience.
