- 2. Students should select MATH191: Precalculus I. MATH 191 transfers to Temple as Math L***. The combination of MATH 191 and MATH 192 satisfies the requirement for STAT 1001: Quantitative Methods for Business I, a major requirement at Temple, via DARS exception. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.
- 3. Students should select MATH 192: Precalculus II. MATH 192 transfers to Temple as MATH L***. The combination of MATH 191 and MATH 192 satisfies the requirement for STAT 1001: Quantitative Methods for Business I, a major requirement at Temple, via DARS exception. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.
- 4. Students should select MATH 265: Calculus I. MATH 265 transfers to Temple as Math L***. This course will satisfy STAT 1102: Quantitative Methods for Business II, a major requirement at Temple, via DARS exception. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.
- 5. The combination of ACCT 161: Principles of Accounting I and ACCT 162: Principles of Accounting II will satisfy the Fox School of Business' ACCT 2101: Financial Accounting requirement.
- 6. Students should select MATH 156: Introduction to Statistics. MATH 156 transfers to Temple as STAT 2101: Statistical



- Methods and Concepts. Students who transfer with MATH 156 will need to take an additional one-credit course STAT 2104: Selected Topics in Statistical Business Analytics during their first semester at Temple to fulfill the four credit STAT 2103 requirement for the program.
- Temple recommends the following sequence of Math courses at OCC: MATH 191, MATH 192, MATH 265, & MATH 156.
 These courses will be used to satisfy the Fox School of Business' Quantitative Sequence of: STAT 1001, STAT 1102, &
 STAT 2101. To earn full credit for STAT 2103, students will need to complete a one-credit course, STAT 2104, at Temple
 upon transfer.
